### KCOK RANCH MOONEY (SR63) IMPROVEMENTS TULARE, CA

TPG Consulting, Inc. provided offsite improvement plans associated with the new development of the KCOK Ranch Subdivision off Mooney Boulevard (SR63) in Tulare, CA. The improvement plans included the installation of two new traffic signals, the first was for the intersection of Mooney Boulevard at Seminole Avenue, being the main driveway entrance for the proposed subdivision. The second signal was proposed for Mooney Boulevard at Cross Avenue. The improvement plans also included pavement widening and median island plans along Mooney Boulevard in order to provide dedicated left and right turn lanes for the proposed access at Seminole Avenue. Associated with these improvements, signing, striping and pavement marking plans were included for Mooney Boulevard, Seminole Avenue and Cross Avenue. In addition, TPG provided encroachment permit applications to Caltrans for improvements within state right-of-way. TPG also provided a three leg roundabout design at Seminal Ave at Morrison Road. This was the first such traffic calming design measure within the City of Tulare. This project demanded continued coordination between the developer, other engineers, utility companies and city and state authorities.
