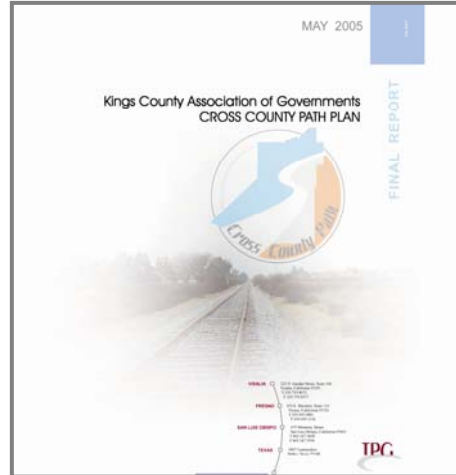

CROSS COUNTY PATH PLAN

KINGS COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS
(2007 CCAPA Central Section Focused Issue Planning Award 1st Place)

TPG Consulting, Inc. with assistance from Alta Planning & Design, a sub-consultant, prepared the Cross County Path Plan for the Kings County Association of Governments. The Plan's purpose was to identify the primary route alignments, design components, funding options and implementation strategies for a multi-use (pedestrian/bicycle) pathway traversing a major portion of Kings County. The Path is planned to run between West Hills Jr. College at the westerly edge of Lemoore east to State Highway 43, east of Hanford, for a total distance of approximately 13 miles, passing through three cities.

TPG outlined the various planning, engineering and environmental constraints and issues of the general cross-county alignment and presented a plan to establish a preferred on-the-ground route that logically and feasibly avoids or resolves these constraints and issues. TPG also presented Kings County with several funding sources available for both bicycle and pedestrian projects.

In July 2007, the California Chapter American Planning Association awarded the Cross County Path Plan 1st Place in the "Focused Issue Planning Award" category, noting "The award appropriately reflects good planning principals and leaves no doubt that [the] submittal is one of the best we've seen here in the Central Valley."
