2006 SHORT RANGE TRANSIT PLAN

CITY OF PORTERVILLE, CA

TPG Consulting, Inc. prepared a Short Range Transit Plan (SRTP) for the City of Porterville. SRTPs are planning documents that describe the plans, programs and goals of a transit agency, and serve as the primary justification for receipt of Federal and State grants for transit operations and capital projects. They are required by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).

The SRTP described Porterville Transit's history, governance, and organizational structure, as well as existing services, including both the fixed route and demand-response systems. The Plan provided an analysis of current ridership and fare structure, and reviewed service and performance standards. The SRTP also presented the results of on-board passenger surveys, reviewed additional service needs, and presented four service alternative options, based on current conditions and key issues being faced by the system.

TPG also outlined an Implementation Plan, showing the direction the system should take over the next five years, including discussions of a Marketing Program, a Management Plan, and a Comprehensive Financial Plan. The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and the Federal Drug Testing Programs were also addressed.

The SRTP provided the community, policy makers, and city staff an opportunity to understand current conditions, define the demand for service over the next five years and to establish an operational and capital plan to meet those demands.
