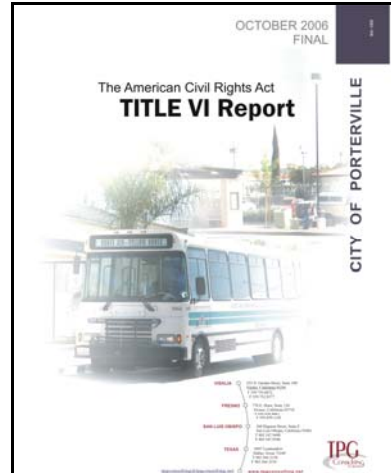

2006 TITLE VI REPORT CITY OF PORTERVILLE, CA

TPG Consulting, Inc. prepared the 2006 Title VI Report for the City of Porterville, in accordance with the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and as required by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). Title VI provisions of the Act require that transit services be made available to all persons regardless of race, color, or national origin. This Report updated the findings contained in previous Porterville Title VI Reports.

The Report included a description of Porterville's existing fixed route (Porterville Transit) and demand-response (COLT) services, and an analysis of the City's current demographic information; TPG looked at the population composition of each census tract within the City of Porterville, based on data from the 2000 U.S. Census, in comparison with existing transit services. The Report also described the current activities associated with the provisions for minority input and access to information related to transit services, developed the City's Language Assistance Plan, and the potential impacts to minority communities and businesses associated with the proposed expansion of the Porterville Bus Maintenance Facility.

The 2006 Title VI Report confirmed that the City's current transit system includes at least one bus route with scheduled stops to serve each of the census tracts within the Porterville transit service area, and that all minority populations within Porterville are being adequately served by the Porterville transit system.

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
