PORTERVILLE TRANSIT CENTER PORTERVILLE, CA

TPG partnered with Canby Associates to provide design work and environmental compliance for the Transit Center in downtown Porterville. A Categorical Exemption (CE) was prepared due to the location of the Transit Center within the downtown redevelopment core area.

The purpose for the project was to provide a centralized location for the routing of buses, coordinate the transit system, provide access to Southern Pacific Railroad and attract revenue-generating enterprises to the area. The City identified the transit center as an essential component of the Porterville Transit Development Plan. The transit center includes nine bus bays, a dispatch center, and a parking lot. The City owned three of the four required parcels, and acquired the remaining parcel through the condemnation process.

TPG Consulting prepared the CE Determination form pursuant to Caltrans requirements and filed the Notice of Exemption with the Tulare County Clerk. The environmental process was streamlined by early and frequent consultation with Caltrans District environmental branches.
