Ms. Miller joined TPG Consulting in 2003 after receiving a B.A. in Geography from Humboldt State University. As an intern with the California Department of Forestry (CDF), she employed applications of GIS on timber harvest data using ArcView Spatial Analyst and Image Analyst software, and assisted in a multi-agency watershed assessment project for Northern California.



As an Assistant Planner for TPG Ms. Miller's responsibilities include transit planning, CEQA and NEPA environmental review and document preparation, and land use planning. In addition, she is responsible for annual traffic count reports, and is involved with various traffic modeling and transportation projects.

Ms. Miller has prepared several transit documents, including the 2006 Short Range Transit Plan (SRTP) for the City of Porterville, a five-year plan for the management and operation of Porterville's transit system, as well as Paratransit and Title VI Report updates for the Cities of Tulare and Porterville. She recently completed 2007 Transit Development Plans for both the cities of Tulare and Exeter.

In addition, Ms. Miller attended a SAFETEA-LU Workshop that addressed Federal transportation coordination efforts and strategies for developing Regional Coordination Plans, and recently completed a Coordinated Transportation Plan for Tulare County.

Her recent environmental workload has included assisting in the preparation of environmental documentation for the expansion of the City of Porterville's Bus Maintenance Facility, and also for the development of a Regional CNG Facility within the City of Porterville. Both projects are partially funded with Federal funds, thus requiring compliance with both Federal and State environmental laws. She also worked on portions of a supplemental EIR for the City of Goleta.

Ms. Miller has assisted with the development of land use density factors for various traffic modeling projects, including the proposed Village of Gateway in Madera. She also worked on the recently updated City of Lemoore Traffic Model. For this project, Ms. Miller was responsible for encoding the InfoUSA employment data by traffic analysis zone and stratification by employment type. She also integrated various Kings County GIS layers, building inspection reports and County Assessor data to create a single family and multi-family housing data layers for the study. In addition, Ms. Miller was responsible for the management and preparation of the 2007 annual traffic count program updates for both the City of Tulare and the Madera County Transportation Commission (MCTC).
